By public transport

From the airport: Take the train **S 5** (departure on ground floor every hour at :06 and :36 minutes), it will take 17 min to the city centre, leave the train S 5 at the Central Station (Hannover Hbf), leave the railway station building at the entrance, go in direction of city centre, at the green Kröpcke long case clock take the small street to the left, you will see the bus stop '**Kröpcke**' (in front of the opera), get on the **Bus Nr. 100** Stop 'Rathaus/Bleichenstr.', leave the bus and you will find the 'Landesmuseum Hannover' 200m across the street.

From the railway station: leave the railway station building at the entrance, go in direction of city centre, at the green Kröpcke long case clock take the small street to the left, you will see the bus stop '**Kröpcke**' (in front of the opera), get on the **Bus Nr. 100** Stop 'Rathaus/Bleichenstr.', leave the bus and you will find the 'Landesmuseum Hannover' across the street.
