W3 Professorship of Pediatrics with specialization In Pediatric Hematology and Oncology

Reference is made to § 61 section 7 of the Hessisches Hochschulgesetz (HHG) and the conditions of employment based on § 62 HHG. Proficient knowledge of the German language is expected.

The professorship is linked to the position of Director of the Department of Pediatric Hematology and Oncology.

The responsibilities arising from chairing a clinical department, including the associated liquidation rights, will be regulated by a contract with University Hospital of Giessen and Marburg GmbH.

The candidate must be able to cover all areas in Pediatric Medicine with a focus on Pediatric Hematology and Oncology in research, academic teaching and patient care. The candidate should be able, based on clinical and academic experience and reputation, to lead and represent the department.

The successful candidate should be internationally recognised in her/his field of research. Cooperation within the existing main research areas of the faculty - cardiopulmonary medicine, infectious diseases and immunology, reproductive- and regeneration-medicine - is demanded.

The candidate should establish active cooperation in research networks and interact with scientific institutions associated with the Justus-Liebig-University Gießen. A close association with existing major research activities of the University as well as the German Center for Lung Research (DZL), the German Center for Infection Research (DZIF), as well as active participation in the Giessen Graduate Center for Life Sciences is expected.

The applicant should have full university education in medicine, a doctorate with merit, outstanding scientific achievements (e. g. habilitation) with experience and excellence in research, based on publications and third party funding. The candidate should have expertise in sourcing and completion of externally financed research projects, in creating national and international research-networks as well as working in interdisciplinary teams. The applicant should also participate in administrative and development processes within the faculty and university. She/he should have exceptional skills in teaching, covering all aspects of the field. The applicant should have a professional certificate for Pediatrics with specialisation in Pediatric Hematology and Oncology. Gender issues should explicitly be integrated in the professorship's research and teaching agenda.

The Justus-Liebig-University aims to employ more women in academic research. We therefore particularly encourage female candidates to apply. JLU is committed to increasing the number of women employed at the university. Justus Liebig University Giessen also aims to increase its faculty leadership with individuals who have competence in dealing with gender and family-related issues. The Justus Liebig University aims to position itself as a family-friendly university and would encourage applicants with children to apply. Applications from disabled people of equal aptitude will be favoured.
